## 4.7 Organisational Set-up and Responsibilities

Government of Liberia will provide strategic directions for the overall implementation of the programmes/projects included under this Action. The Government of Liberia coordination will be facilitated through the Aid Management Coordination Unit (AMCU) of the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning, in close consultation and coordination with the line institutions concerned (notably MoA, NaFAA, LACRA, CARI, MoCI – NSL).

Each individual project/contract will have a Steering Committee to discuss progress at regular intervals. Implementing partners will brief so that EU Delegation and Government of Liberia line institutions along with major stakeholders can provide guidance.

As part of its prerogative of budget implementation and to safeguard the financial interests of the Union, the Commission may participate in the above governance structures set up for governing the implementation of the action and may sign or enter into joint declarations or statements, for the purpose of enhancing the visibility of the EU and its contribution to this action and ensuring effective coordination.
