

- Strengthening awareness and capacity to disrupt the criminal business models of criminal organisations active in drug trafficking in Peru (drugs prosecution model to be reviewed and support the operationalisation and internationalization of joint specific investigation and prosecution teams).
- Increase the effectiveness of supervision with a special focus on drugs precursors and logistical (maritime drugs trafficking) and digital channels.
- Promote exchange of information data system compatible between actors for exchange of data (national, regional and EU/Peru level) through innovative, structured and digitalized technologies.

### 3.3 Mainstreaming

#### **Environmental Protection & Climate Change**

**Outcomes of the EIA (Environmental Impact Assessment) screening** (relevant for projects and/or specific interventions within a project)

The EIA (Environment Impact Assessment) screening classified the action as category B (not requiring an EIA, but for which environment aspects will be addressed during the design of the Action).

The action will include the fight against environmental crimes, thus mainstreaming environmental and biodiversity protection in its design.

#### **Gender equality and empowerment of women and girls**

As per OECD Gender DAC codes identified in section 1.1, this action is labelled as G1.

This implies that gender equality is a significant objective with particular attention to tackling especially the fight against all forms of gender-based violence (key thematic priority area & of the GAP III joint communication) contributing to increasing prosecution of perpetrators including those involved in human trafficking (including drug mules), by strengthening a victim-centred approach by the law-enforcement bodies

Relatively the drugs component, it is necessary to mainstream a gender perspective into and ensure the involvement of women in all stages of the development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of drug policies and programmes, develop and disseminate gender-sensitive and age-appropriate measures that take into account the specific needs and circumstances faced by women and girls

#### **Human Rights**

The action will follow a **human-rights based approach** (applying all human rights for all, meaningful and inclusive participation and access to decision-making, non-discrimination and equality, accountability and rule of law for all, and transparency and access to information supported by disaggregated data) and will be complementary of current and on-going action in the areas of governance, gender and human rights (inclusively human rights defenders). The action will have a direct impact in this area through the Joint Investigation Teams on human right defenders' homicides.

#### **Disability**

As per OECD Disability DAC codes identified in section 1.1, this action is labelled as D0. Nevertheless, in line with 2030 EU Disability Strategy accessibility to seminars, events, workshops and information of persons with disabilities will be promoted throughout the activities of the facility.

#### **Reduction of inequalities**

The action thought not considered relevant for inequality reduction and therefore labelled as I-0 however it is complementary from other on-going support aiming territorial development in the coca growing VRAEM region in Peru though the promotion of economic development strategies, the diversification agricultural production
